

## English II Class Rules & Expectations --- Ms. Gray, Room 48

1. Be on time and prepared to work!
2. Stay on task with all assignments and activities.
3. Respect the teacher's duty to teach and each student's right to learn---listen quietly/attentively when teaching and learning are taking place.

8. Mind your own personal property and be respectful of property belonging to the school, the teacher, and other students. Keep the desks, shelves, floors, etc. clean of trash and keep books off the floor and in their proper place.
9. Profanity or distasteful/disrespectful remarks will not be tolerated!
10. When returning from an absence and/or needing makeup work, students should check the daily assignments notebook. If any work is missing from the notebook, see me at the end of the class period! It is the student's responsibility to arrange a makeup date for quizzes and tests. All missed work must be turned in no later than five days after the missed class or a zero grade will be given!
11. You will keep up with your assignments, work in class, and notebook.
